<u>Before You Begin</u>: These components must be correctly installed prior to using this appliance. Completely read the instructions before attempting this installation.

Procedure:


1) Sprinkle loose vermiculite in channel between the bottom casting and the side / rear castings. Avoid getting vermiculite in the secondary air opening and on the surfaces where the stones sit. (GM 40 only)







2) Place the rear (vermiculite) insulation panel against the center of the rear casting.



3) Place the secondary air assembly into the stove. The bottom tube will fit into the opening in the bottom casting. *Note: It will be locked in place by the installation of the refractory stones.*






4) Place the rear stones into the stove as shown.



5) Place the left and right stones into the stove, exactly as shown-with the cut portion up and facing into the firebox.










6) Place the right baffle into the stove. Push it fully to the right so that it sits on the cutout in the side stone.



7) While lifting the rear portion of the right baffle, insert the left baffle by engaging the rear and tipping up the front. IMPORTANT – do not force the pieces as they could break or crack – they will fit together without forcing them into place. The two baffles will overlap at the center joint and sit in the grooves of the left and right stones.





8) Place the baffle guard over the front edge of the baffles. Push it as far back as it will go, onto the baffle plates.



9) Place the bottom refractory stones into the stove.
