Soapstone Steamer Assembly #90-99112

This is a natural product made from selected soapstone. Slight variations in size and coloration are natural and typical. As you use this steamer, it will change hue and take on a more aged look. For extra enjoyment, add your favorite mulling spices or other natural fragrant materials to the water. Bay Leaf, Cinnamon Sticks, Eucalyptus leaf are a few examples. We do not suggest chemical fragrances.

Assembly Components:

Soapstone steamer, pot only part # 1941-150 Soapstone steamer, cast iron flat black enamel lid part # 2912-150

A correctly pre treated Soapstone Steamer will give you a lifetime of use.

- Apply a thin coating of vegetable or olive oil over entire soapstone surface, inside and out. Surface will appear darker. DO NOT TREAT LID!
- Fill to near top with water and place in a cool oven, turn on oven heat to 350° F and bake for two hours.
- Wash the steamer gently with soap and water to remove any excess oil (which may stain your stove).

Fill with water, put lid on and enjoy!

Please:

- Do NOT move or drag your Steamer across the surface of your Soapstone stove. It can scratch the stove. Ensure the bottom of the steamer is clean and grit free before placing it on your stove.
- **▲** To fill, either add water through the lid with a plant watering can, or remove lid (Use a mitten or tool).
- Lensure you maintain a minimum of water in the steamer. Do not continue to heat your steamer after the water evaporates, it could be damaged or destroyed.
- To avoid cracking do not add a large amount of very cold water to a hot, dry Steamer pot.
- ▲ A pot and lid, left to heat without water will be much hotter than one with water in it. Be careful!
- Do not drop either piece of the assembly.
- If you must use abrasive cleaners on the soapstone, re-treat with oil.
- **b** Do not use abrasives on the lid.



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
