# Installation of the Morgan/Clydesdale Surround Extension Kit

## **KIT CONTENTS:**

### **TOOLS <u>REQUIRED:</u>**

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1 – Left panel

1 – Right panel

Screwdriver, flat blade

- 1 Center panel
- 4 Tapped corner connectors (with holes)
- 4 Back plates connectors (without holes)
- 8 Set screws

Note: Only install the surround extension kit on a cold insert. Make sure the fire in the unit has been out for at least 5 hours.

### **PROCEDURE:**

- 1. Carefully unpack the surround from its shipping container.
- 2. Place the surround panels face down on a soft surface. Place the mitered ends of the left and right panels flush to the mitered ends of the center panel
- 3. Slide an untapped *back plate connector* and a *tapped corner connector* into the two slots on both side panels. (Make sure the tapped corner connectors are on the top, facing you.)
- 4. Place the *center panel* in place by sliding the *corner connectors* in the slots on the mitered ends. Push the corners together firmly and evenly, while tightened the set screws. Take care to not over tighten the screws.
- 5. Gently pull the Morgan/Clydesdale away from the fireplace about 2 inches.
- 6. Next, stand the assembled surround extension up on the *left* and *right panels*. Lift, by the *center panel*, and slide down behind the Morgan/Clydesdale existing surround.
- 7. Center the surround extension around the existing unit to a position of your liking.
- 8. Carefully push the insert back into place, gently sandwiching the surround extension in place.
