
## CART ASSEMBLY

## N.B. To assemble the product described below, you may need the help of one or more people.


1- Place the bottom shelf upside down, protect the surface using a piece of cardboard or a packing sheet. Fix the four wheels using the M6x15 screws with the respective washers, screw them on the threaded inserts already pre-assembled. Be careful to place the wheels with brakes where there are the two specific openings provided for rotation.




2- Put the shelf with wheels back in the original position. We recommend blocking the two wheels by activating the brakes. Take the left side of the cart and screw it with five M5x16 screws as shown in the image below. You may need the help of another person to hold the cart side.




**3-** Take the intermediate shelf and place it in the appropriate slots on the left side. Secure it with four M5x16 screws. You may need the help of another person to hold the cart side.



**4-** While keeping the intermediate shelf, place the right side and fix it to the intermediate shelf and to the bottom shelf using eight M5x16 screws.




5- Take the two crossbars of the trolley with the guides already pre-assembled. Be sure the guides are properly closed. Place them between the two sides, taking care to position the one with the door closing magnets at the front. Fix them with four M5x16 screws per crossbar.




6- Pull out the guides and let them come out of the rectangular slot on the left side. Once outside you can assemble the side shelf, paying attention to the symbols. For the 80x60 oven, secure it with four M4x10 screws to the inserts showing the square symbol. For the 60x60 model secure the shelf with 6 M4x10 screws to the symbols showing a triangle.
 The 100x80 model will have its own side shelf to be fixed with four M4x10 screws.




7- Take the two door handles and fix them to the doors by using two 4.2x16 self-drilling screws.




8- Mount the two doors by inserting the pins on the doors into the appropriate hinges already mounted on the sides of the cart.

First insert the upper pin (the longer one) into the outer hole on the upper hinge and then insert the lower one into the lower hinge, always using the outer hole.




9- Mount the rear panel of the cart using five M5x16 screws as shown in the image below.




**10-** If you want to place the cylinder inside the cart, fix the back cylinder support bracket with two M5x16 screws and two 5x15 washers



**11-** Insert the cylinder until it comes into contact with the previously fixed back cylinder support bracket.




12- Stop the cylinder with the front support bracket. Fix it using two M5x16 screws and the respective 5x15 washers. The support bracket has two slots that allow it to slide until the bracket fits perfectly with the cylinder.



## ASSEMBLY THE OVEN ON THE CART

The oven is heavy, you will need the help of more people to lift it up. If you have a crane, you can hook the oven to the bar across the flue opening.


14- When the oven is safely placed on the cart, take the diaphragm and place it over the flue opening.




**15-** Take the chimney flue and insert it on the flue opening of the oven.



**16-** Insert the chimney cap.



**17-** You can fix the cap to the flue using the 4.2x16 self-drilling screw supplied.



**18-** Secure the tool holder accessory to the right side of the cart using two M5x16 screws.
